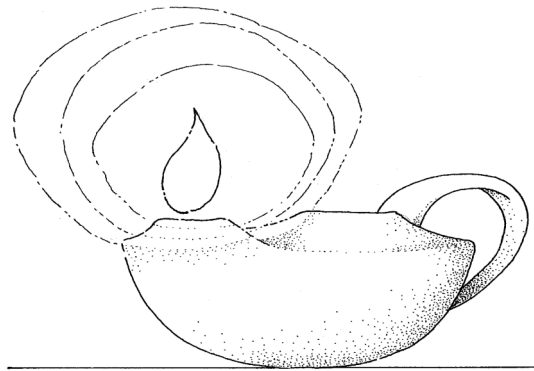

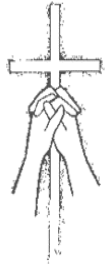
Notary Service
