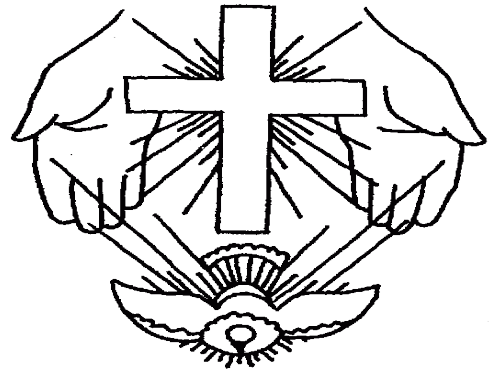

SEMINAR ON PRAYER & LIFE IN HOLY SPIRIT

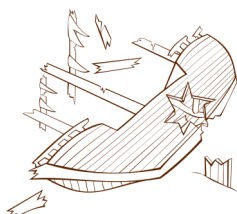
